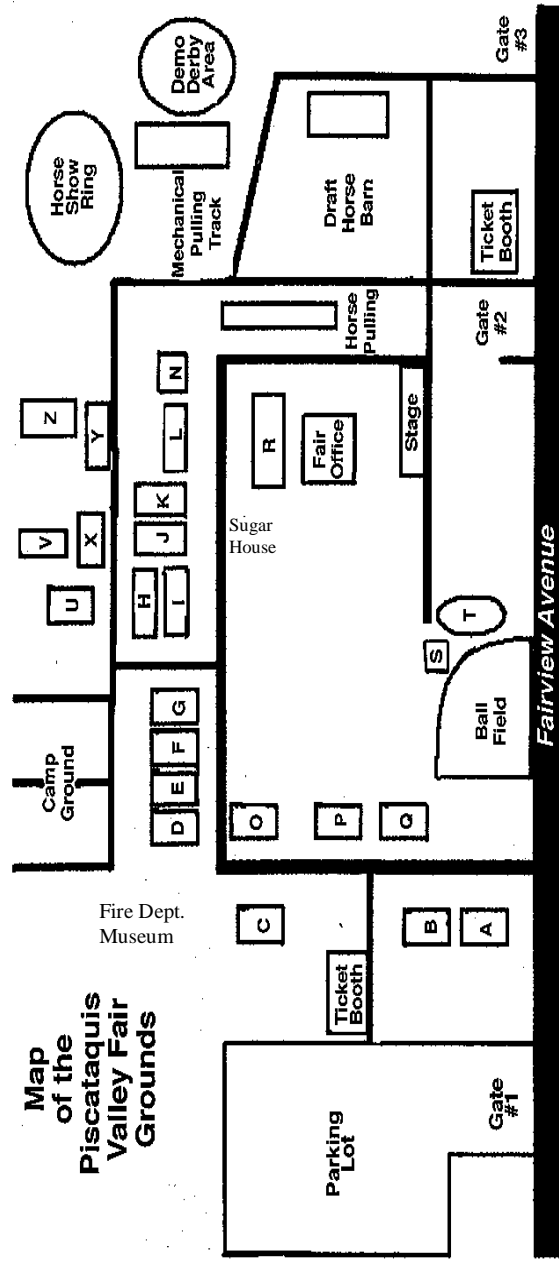


**MAP OF FAIRGROUNDS**

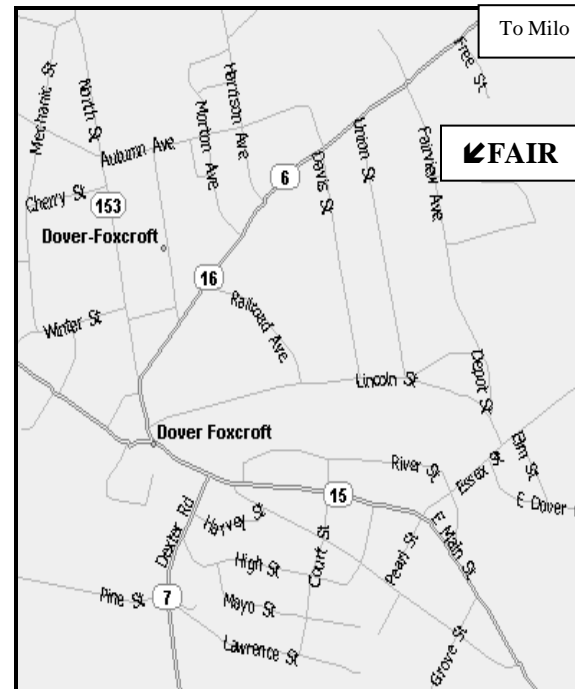
