Ivan Smith Jr. was an active member of Piscataquis Valley Fair for over 40 years, serving in many capacities.

In the earlier years, Ivan oversaw the upkeep of the grounds, maintaining equipment and was in charge of hall rentals. During the fair, he assisted with various fair-time activities, including frog jumping and arm wrestling competitions. He was also in charge of water maintenance and its intricate latticework on the grounds.

For many years, Ivan was the proprietor of Ivan’s Place, a place for members to relax and discuss fair business.

As Ivan’s health began failing him, he kept in touch via phone, offering his advice and suggestions. His love for the fair was evident and for this and his “gentle giant” presence, we will miss him. We will remember him with love.

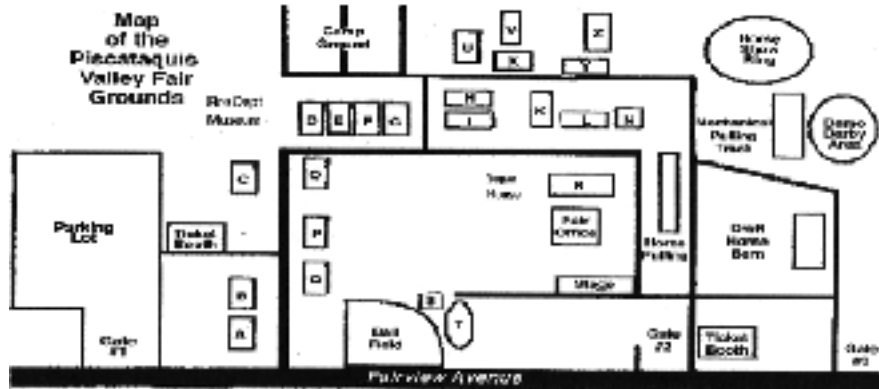
